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## RULES & BEHAVIORAL AGREEMENT

New Beginnings Are Possible uses assertive discipline techniques to strengthen good behavior by the use of positive reinforcement such as verbal praise, smiles, awards, etc. Subsequently, inappropriate behaviors are subject to the below listed consequences. This helps to ensure that all children and coordinators have a positive, rewarding experience! Please read the rules below with your child. By signing the NBAP Rules/ Behavior Agreement section on the NBAP Authorization Form, you and your child are agreeing to follow the rules and understand the consequences if you don't.

### NBAP PROGRAM RULES:

- Treat staff, volunteers and other children with respect.
- No name-calling, foul language, or bullying/ fighting.
- Follow staff instructions.
- Any electronic devices brought to NBAP programs are the child's responsibility. Electronic devices may be used only during extended hours.
- Do not bring candy to NBAP programs.
- Stay with your group.
- Respect nature and animals.
- If you're not sure (about anything), ask first.
- Have fun! (no whining, moaning or groaning)

### CONSEQUENCES:

- Verbal warning
- Supervised time-out away from the group
- Parents/guardian notified of inappropriate behavioral
- Dismissal from camp.

#### **Behavioral Dismissal Policy:**

Program fees are non-refundable if a child is removed for disciplinary reasons. Physical violence or bullying toward another child or staff member will result in immediate dismissal from the program and you will not be refunded for the current week.

### COMMUNICATION:

As necessary, communication between NBAP and parent/ guardian will be via email. Please check your email daily. If you have any questions about these rules, please ask a staff member. We will do our best to fairly enforce them.
